

## Healthy People 2020 Summary of Objectives

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### Healthcare-Associated Infections

<b>Number</b>	<b>Objective Short Title</b>
HAI-1	Central line-associated bloodstream infections
HAI-2	Methicillin-resistant <i>Staphylococcus aureus</i> infections

## Topic Area: Healthcare-Associated Infections

**HAI-1:** Reduce central line-associated bloodstream infections (CLABSI).

Target: 0.25 Standardized Infection Ratio (SIR) or 75 percent reduction.

Baseline: 1.00 SIR was reported in 2006–08.

Target setting method: Consistency with national programs/regulations/policies/laws.

Data source: National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN), CDC.

**HAI-2:** Reduce invasive healthcare-associated methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA) infections.

Target: 6.56 infections per 100,000 persons or 75 percent reduction.

Baseline: 26.24 infections per 100,000 persons were reported in 2007–08.

Target setting method: Consistency with national programs/regulations/policies/laws.

Data source: Emerging Infections Program (EIP) network Active Bacterial Core surveillance (ABCs), CDC.
